### **PRACTICAL INFORMATION**

**Please note that to attend the excursion, you need to sign up in advance by 20 August [here](#).**

**We will meet in front of the Sibelius Museum at 15:40.**

Please note that due to the tight schedule, we will not be taking attendance before leaving. Please make sure that you are out in front of the Museum at exactly 15:40.

**Bus 8 to Ruissalo leaves at 16:00 from the bus stop Kauppatori A8.**

You can also come directly to the bus if you are not attending the preceding sessions at the Museum.

**Participants are kindly asked to pay the bus fare themselves.**

The single journey ticket is 3 € and can be bought via the Föli mobile app or on the bus by debit/credit card or cash. With cash payment the price is 4 €. You can also use a Föli travel card if you have one.

**The address of the Saaronniemi beach is Saarontie 59, 20100 Turku.**

You can also come to Saaronniemi by car if you prefer. The location of Saaronniemi parking can be found in the [Turku map service](#). 3-hour free parking is generally available, but parking fees may apply during high season. The group taking the bus will arrive at approx. 16:30.

**When arriving at the beach, we will walk together to Kolkannokka for the sensory excursion.**

The session is fairly accessible to many abilities, and we will move onwards as slowly as required. The location is not entirely accessible for wheelchairs: The road to the Kolkannokka cape is a gravel road, and towards the tip of the cape, the terrain becomes somewhat uneven and marked by stones.

**Please bring your own water bottle and dress according to the weather and the likely windy conditions.**

Aboagora will offer a small snack to participants.

There are lavatories, including accessible lavatories, at the main beach that are free of charge.

During the excursion, there is a possibility for swimming. Please bring your own swimsuit, towel, etc. if you wish to swim.

**The return bus leaves at 18:00 from Saaronniemi beach and arrives at Kauppatori at 18:35.**

There is enough time to walk to the Sibelius Museum for the keynote by Karen Barad (at 19:00).

**In case of heavy rain, we will sense the regenerative void and what floats to the shores behind the Sibelius Museum by the riverside.**
